Lifeguard

General Function:

Under the supervision of the Aquatics Director/Coordinator and in accordance with the Christian mission of the YMCA, a Lifeguard is responsible for ensuring the safety of facility patrons by preventing and responding to emergencies.

Principle Activities:

- Responsible for the safety of facility patrons
- Enforces all of the facility's policies, rules, and regulations
- Recognizes and responds effectively to emergencies
- Responds to patron inquiries and concerns and provides Branch information as needed
- Inspects the aquatic facility on a daily schedule and reports unsafe conditions and equipment to supervisor
- Completes records and reports regarding the following: hourly patron attendance, water chemistry, incidents and accidents
- Participates in meetings and in-service training
- Conduct aquatic facility maintenance as assigned

Aquatics Camp Counselor

General Functions

- Provide leadership and guidance for a group of campers.
- Provide growth and development opportunities for each camper.
- Development and operation of all aspects of program schedule.
- Provide opportunities for development of awareness in each camper.
- Provide an enjoyable experience for each camper.

Principle Activities

- Build and maintain a positive environment for all campers.
- Supervise and ensure the safety of campers before and after program hours.
- Execute your lesson plans, as a part of daily program.
- Incorporate weekly themes into daily activities.
- Assist in providing a positive learning experience for CLT, CIT or any teen camper.
- Assist in lifeguarding and swim with your group during group swim time.
- Manage appropriate behavior with all children and implement the Camp's discipline policy.
- Participate in all assigned activities like sleepovers, family nights, etc.
- Share problems with Camp Director/ Leadership Staff so they can be solved
- Maintain responsibility of "special duty" assigned weekly.

Swim Instructor

General Function:

Under the supervision of the Aquatics Director/Coordinator and in accordance with the Christian mission of the YMCA, the Swim Instructor is responsible for teaching swim lessons according to YMCA of the USA program standards.

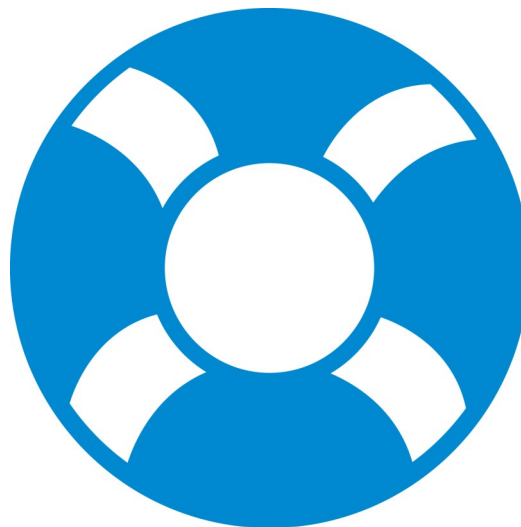
Principle Activities:

- Teach swim lessons according to YMCA of the USA standards
- Create a positive learning environment through personal enthusiasm
- Be safety-conscious, maintain order and enforce rules during lessons to ensure swimmer safety
- Keep accurate records of attendance and skills achieved by each student, each session.
- Provide each student with written records of progress
- Use swim aids effectively to maximize each individual's practice time
- Utilize written lesson plans for each lesson to make the most efficient use of class time.
- Participate in all staff meetings and in-service training
- Conduct program evaluations.
- Carries out additional duties as assigned by supervisor

Swim Party Host

Principle Activities:

- Responsible for set up of birthday party area, to include decorations.
- Instruct the children in the birthday party outline or the swimming party suggestions.
- Aid parents in the carrying of presents, cakes, etc and all party supplies, when needed.
- Give assistance to parents to include cutting of cake, serving of cake, responding to parents' specific needs and requests.
- Upkeep and cleaning of party room, tables, chairs, floors, and mirrors.
- Risk management maintenance of the aquatics center including locking of the doors.
- Distribution of goodie bags when appropriate.
- Be available to membership for questions, com-

- This position will not have lifeguard responsibilities but will direct traffic down the slide and around the pool
- Create a positive environment through personal enthusiasm and promote opportunities for the spiritual growth of each member in our community
- Be safety-conscious, maintain order and enforce rules during hours of operation to ensure swimmer safety;
- The incumbent is expected to set a good example in promptness, manners and appearance
- Demonstrate willingness to assist fellow staff and members and take initiative to accomplish daily
